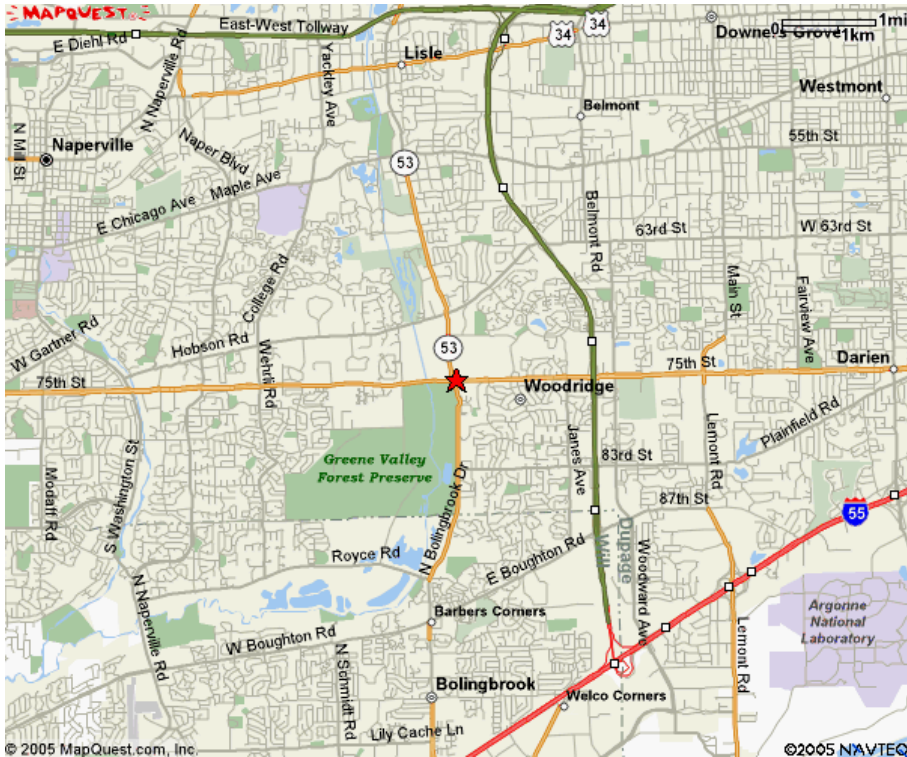


Greene Valley Forest Preserve is located south of 79th street just west of Greene Road. Greene Road is the first street west of Route 53 on 75th Street in Naperville.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

A drawing will be held on Tuesday, October 6, 2009 at approximately 8pm at the Odeum, 1033 N. Villa Ave., Villa Park, IL to determine which entries will participate in the tests and the position of excess entries on the alternate list. All entries will be advised in writing of the results of the draw. The drawing will be open to the public.

In this combined TD/TDX test, if the limit is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in another test, the number of tracks may be exchanged, up to a maximum of 12 TD or 6 TDX tests.

Each dog entering the Tracking Dog Test must have been certified to be ready for such a test within one year of the date of the test. This certification must be made by a person approved by the AKC to judge tracking tests.

In the Tracking Test, dogs holding a Tracking Dog title shall not be barred from competition, but dogs not having this title will be given preference.

A dog entering a Tracking Dog Excellent test must have a confirmed TD title.

Dogs holding a Tracking Dog Excellent title shall not be barred from competition, but dogs not having this title will be given preference.

The entry fee will be refunded for an alternate that does not participate. That entry fee shall be refunded within seven (7) days following the test.

Entries which pass an AKC approved test after the closing date of this test may withdraw from this test with entry refunded provided there is an alternate to replace the entry and the Test Secretary is notified not less than 3 days before the test date.

BITCHES IN SEASON – Chapter 2, Section 8

Any bitch, which appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element, is considered to be in season. The Test Secretary and Judges must be notified that a bitch (or bitches) is in her season prior to the drawing for tracks. The last track(s) to be run shall be reserved for the bitch(es) in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held. Bitches in season will be allowed to participate in a Test only after all other dogs not in season have been tested.

Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.
